Saturday 3 October 2026

Arrive into Launceston Airport (**flights not included in tour cost – arrange own flights from Sydney after RSIC2026**)* Arrive by 5:00pm.

Private coach: Pick up at airport to meet arriving flights and transfer to accommodation.

Launceston Cataract Gorge: A forested river reserve wrapped around a dramatic gorge, just a short distance from Launceston's city centre. Explore by walking the tracks around the First Basin.

Dove Lake Circuit: One of Tasmania's premier nature walks at the foot of Cradle Mountain. (Half tour group)

Devils at Cradle: A unique conservation sanctuary for Tasmania's threatened carnivorous marsupials – The Tasmanian Devil. Evening private feeding tour.

Coles Bay: A popular holiday town at the gateway to Freycinet National Park.

Wineglass Bay Lookout: Walk to one of Tasmania's most celebrated views in the picturesque Freycinet National Park.

Swansea: Spring Beach – photo stop

Port Arthur Historic Site: This UNESCO World Heritage-listed site is the best preserved convict settlement in Australia. Explore the many historic buildings, ruins and gardens

Dinner: Port Arthur Motor Inn

Eaglehawk Neck: Explore the natural, rugged coastline including the Blowhole, Tasman Arch and Devils Kitchen.

Richmond: Wander around the charming historic town home to Australia's oldest bridge

Lunch: Bonorong Wildlife Sanctuary

Bonorong Wildlife Sanctuary: Established as a sanctuary for injured and orphaned wildlife and home to Tasmanian Devils, wombats, echidnas, quolls, and birds

Dinner: Old Woolstore

Overnight: Hobart

Thursday 8 October 2026

Breakfast: included at accommodation

Mount Wellington: Travel to the top for spectacular views of Hobart and Southern Tasmania.

MONA: Ferry from Hobart wharf to one of Australia's most unique art museums.

Lunch: Mures Lower Deck

TMAG: Explore Tasmania's premier museum for natural and cultural heritage

Dinner: Old Woolstore

Overnight: Hobart

Friday 9 October 2026
